CAPABILITY SCOTLAND GIFT AID TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By completing the Gift Aid Declaration Form you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. You are a UK taxpayer and would like Capability Scotland to reclaim tax on this and any future donations you may make until you notify us otherwise. If you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations in that tax year it is your responsibility to pay any difference.
2. Capability Scotland will act as an agent on your behalf to sell the goods you have donated at a price they consider appropriate, and you agree to a commission of 1% for this service.
3. Capability Scotland will, at their discretion decide whether your goods are in a saleable condition. Any items unsold cannot be returned and may be sent for recycling.
4. Capability Scotland will write to you by post or email when some/all of your goods have been sold to confirm the net value of the proceeds and to offer you a payment of this sum in full or part. You will have 21 days to reply to us from the date of the correspondence should you wish to retain part or all of the net proceeds.
5. Should we not receive a reply within 21 days we will assume your consent that the net proceeds are to be donated to Capability Scotland through Gift Aid.
6. Please let us know of any change to your address/contact details or if you no longer pay sufficient tax so that we can update our records.
